### MUNICIPAL PROJECTS

#### Parking guidance system

As part of its smart city strategy, the Town of Diekirch will introduce a parking guidance system across the municipality by April 2026, which will be managed by the Luxembourg-based company RMS. This intelligent system for managing parking spaces is based on various sensors and allows traffic to be relieved and parking spaces to be used optimally. This allows the residents of Diekirch and visitors to the town to benefit from the car parks here in a modern way. Work on the car park guidance system has already begun; the cabling for the nine signs, which will later indicate available parking spaces, is currently being installed.



### FESTIVALS & EVENTS

#### A CAPE'IIa Festival – Latvian Voices

Since 2016, CAPE from Ettelbrück, together with the Town of Diekirch, has organised the A CAPE'IIa Festival every two years – the first and only festival in Luxembourg where spectators can immerse themselves in the multifaceted world of singing and vocal music. On Sunday 1 February at 11 am, the concert 'Latvian Voices' will take place in the Old Church in Diekirch. This renowned a cappella ensemble combines Latvian folk songs and their celebrated choral tradition with a modern a cappella sound.



#### Literature Wednesday

For the final reading as part of Literature Wednesday in the Old Church, on 11 February you can expect author and musician Roland Meyer, who will be reading from his new book, "Um Horizont". Together with musicians Noémie Leer and Mulles Scholtes, Roland Meyer entangles his listeners in a web of allusions, half-truths and rumours from the worlds of film, art, literature and travel.



## Carnival Weekend in Diekirch

From the 12th to the 15th of February, it's carnival time again in Diekirch. Together with a number of local clubs, the "Eselen aus der Sauerstad Dikrich" have once again put together a programme where young and old alike can have a great time. On Thursday and Friday evenings the carnival crazies are welcomed in several cafés in Diekirch, on Saturday the little carnival revellers are out and about in the multi-purpose hall 'Al Seeërei' and on Sunday the Cavalcade takes place from 2:00 pm with its traditional parade around the town centre of Diekirch. **Reminder:** From 12:00 noon, the town of Diekirch will be closed to traffic.



## CLIMATE NEWS

### Valorlux Bags

As the municipality is currently receiving a limited stock of Valorlux bags, the administration is also forced to restrict their distribution. Therefore, the blue bags are now only available at the town hall at 27 Avenue de la Gare.

#### A quick reminder:

**The blue bag is for:** plastic packaging, metal packaging and drink cartons.

**Not permitted:** paper, cardboard, black plastic, styrofoam, coffee capsules, multi-layer packaging such as coffee, crisp or pet food bags, packaging for medicines, packaging with GHS symbols and hazardous objects such as syringes. The packaging does **not** need to be rinsed before being placed in the blue bag!

### Message to dog owners in the municipality of Diekirch
