CONSTRUCTION SITES

Construction progress: SIDEN

Work on the construction of a new sewer by the Inter-municipal Union for Wastewater Treatment in the North (SIDEN) along the cycle path between the Steel footbridge and the *Ficelles* Bridge (Cable-stayed footbridge) is due to begin at the end of June. In the first phase, the pipes will be laid between the *Ficelles* Bridge and the *Sûre* Bridge. If everything goes according to plan, this work should be completed by the summer holidays. After the summer holidays, work on the *Sûre* Bridge will resume, so that by early to mid-September the level of the campsite will have been reached. The SIDEN works on the site in Diekirch should be finally completed in October.

Participatory Budgeting II

In 2025, the municipality's first participatory budgeting scheme was launched, aimed at strengthening community life or improving public spaces in collaboration with all residents. Cemetery visit

The meeting point is at the entrance to the old cemetery.



National Day

This year's National Day celebrations in Diekirch begin on **17 June** at 10 am with the military parade on *Kluuster* Square (Place Guillaume). On **22 June**, the big folk festival returns to *Kluuster* – a family festival for young and old begins at 7 pm. The highlight of the evening is a newly designed drone show at 11.15 pm. On **23 June**, National Day itself, the festive *Te Deum* will take place at 10 am in the parish church. Afterwards, at 11 am, the procession of dignitaries from the town of Diekirch will form on the *Bottermaart* (Place Bech) and then proceed to *Kluuster*. There, the mayor will deliver the traditional speech at 11.30 am. To round off the event, the municipality invites everyone to an aperitif at the *Kluuster*.



Donkey Festival

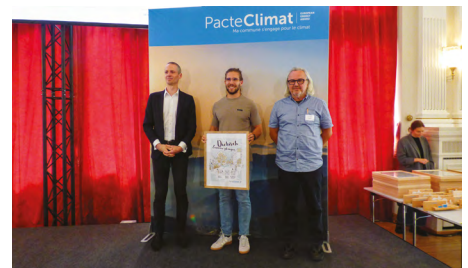
On **27 June**, the second edition of the Diekirch Donkey Festival will take place, which emerged last year from the *Dikrich feiert den Esel*-Celebration and the summer sales. In addition to the lovely stalls and the entertainment programme in the town park, there will also be a large street market in the town centre on the day. To link the two venues, a fun donkey rally is being organised, where participants must search for little donkeys both in the park and in the shops. Participants will be entered into a prize draw with lots of great prizes to be won. The Donkey Festival takes place from 10:00 to 18:00.



CLIMATE NEWS

At the 14th Climate Pact Day on 8 May at the Municipal Circle in Luxembourg City, the municipality of Diekirch was honoured for achieving 50% certification under the Climate Pact 2.0. This means that the town of Diekirch has implemented more than half of the measures set out in its vision document. This threshold was already exceeded in 2022. A follow-up audit in October 2025 then showed that 61.6% had been achieved. This confirmed the 50 per cent threshold. Consequently, Diekirch can expect to receive an award for 65% certification at the next Climate Pact Day.
